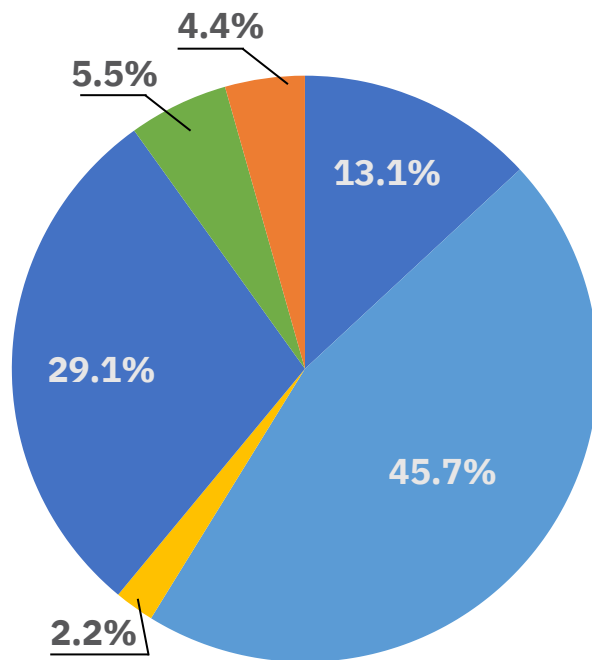

## About the World Federation of Societies of Biological Psychiatry

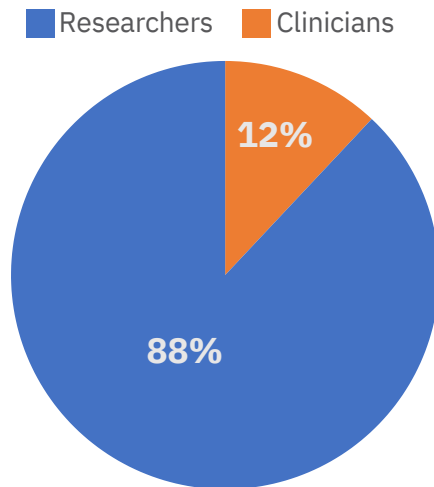
